RE: Integrating Markets and Public Policy (IMAPP) – Proposed Stakeholder Schedule

Included with this memorandum is a proposed stakeholder schedule for NEPOOL to be in a position at its December 2, 2016 Annual Meeting to provide guidance to ISO New England (ISO-NE) on adjustments to New England's wholesale power markets to be pursued to accomplish public policy objectives of New England states through the wholesale power market. In order for Market Participants and State Officials to be equipped with as much information and analysis as possible in advance of the December 2 Annual Meeting, the proposed schedule contemplates in October that NEPOOL would identify for ISO-NE a limited set of conceptual market design changes ("Framework Document(s)") for analysis and feasibility assessment by ISO-NE. The objective would be for State Officials and Market Participants to explore those Framework Document(s) together and, with the benefit of ISO-NE analyses and input, as well as analysis being conducted by the New England States Committee on Electricity (NESCOE), to identify those market changes to be pursued and a timetable for completing the work necessary to implement the selected changes.

This proposed schedule has been assembled by the NEPOOL officers with input from ISO-NE and State Officials. It is admittedly aggressive. Whenever possible, with the concurrence of ISO-NE, the schedule has IMAPP meetings taking place on previously-scheduled Markets Committee meeting days. For your benefit, this memorandum and all materials pertaining to this process will be posted on the NEPOOL website (http://nepool.com/IMAP.php).

Please let us or a NEPOOL officer know if you have comments on this proposed schedule, which will be reviewed at the kick-off meeting.

August Meetings

August 11, 2016 -- A formal notice of this kick-off meeting to be held *at the Colonnade Hotel in Boston* was circulated on June 30. As reflected in that notice, NEPOOL's August 11 meeting will initiate the solution identification process, with presentations by numerous stakeholders on their ideas for constructive changes. As previously noticed, in anticipation of that meeting, final presentations are to be sent to the NEPOOL Secretary *no later than noon on August 4, 2016*, and we will post materials in advance of this meeting at http://nepool.com/IMAP.php.

August 30, 2016 -- This second meeting will be held *at the Seaport Hotel in Boston*. A summary of the August 11 presentations will be prepared for that meeting and stakeholders will have an opportunity at this meeting to react to and provide input concerning each of the

proposals and the objective(s) that each is aimed at achieving. Stakeholders will be invited to refine, combine or augment their proposals based on questions or feedback.

September and October Meetings

Meetings have been scheduled for **September 14, 2016** and **October 6, 2016** (each the 2nd day of regularly-scheduled MC meeting). Those meetings will be for further discussion and refinement of proposals and to hear ISO-NE and State Officials' preliminary thoughts on the proposals. The schedule also proposes a special Markets Committee meeting for **October 21, 2016**, with the objective of having by then sufficient clarity on the proposals and input from ISO-NE and State Officials so that the Markets Committee is in a position to provide direction, through non-binding vote or otherwise, on the "Framework Documents" that NEPOOL would like ISO-NE to analyze.

November Meeting

The schedule contemplates a meeting on **November 10, 2016** (2nd day of regularly-scheduled MC meeting) with the hope at this time that stakeholders will have the benefit of the initial work completed by ISO-NE on the 2016 NEPOOL Economic Study request and any other ISO-NE or NESCOE observations related to the Framework Documents then under consideration. With Thanksgiving two weeks later, there is not another convenient time for the Markets Committee to meet on this topic, although if needed the officers did discuss the possibility of a meeting on November 29 or 30, earlier in the week of the NEPOOL Annual Meeting.

December Meeting

As noted up front, the schedule calls for NEPOOL at the **December 2, 2016** Participants Committee Annual Meeting to take an indicative vote on Frameworks Document(s). The form of vote would be formulated with the intent of providing sufficient guidance to the States and ISO-NE that could be used to set a clear path forward.
