COME CLIMB MOUNT PIERCE!



For those interested Dan Allegretti, who lives in the area and volunteers with the US Forest Service, will lead a hike to the summit of Mount Pierce. This moderate intensity hike will leave from the Mount Clinton Road parking lot, about 5 minutes' drive down Route 302 from the hotel. To reach the 4.310-foot summit will take approximately 4 hours and will cover a total distance of 6.2 miles. The hike will be along the famous Crawford Path, which is part of the Appalachian Trail and is believed to be the oldest hiking path in America. Most of the hike will be below tree line, however, the summit itself will afford spectacular views of the Presidential Mountains, including Mount Washington.
